What is the Project Appraisal Document (PAD)?

The PAD describes specific activities funded by the GFF and the amount of funding the country will receive as a grant and loans. These activities are only some of those that are included in the country's overall RMNCAH+N strategy under the One Plan II.

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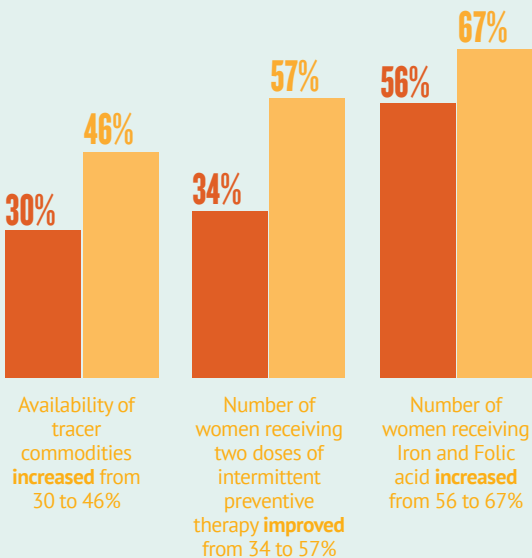
