The projects' implementing partners meet with the senior government officials to introduce them to C-MPDSR and have their buy-in on the project.



The projects' implementing partners meet to co-create and design the project based on the initial context analysis.



A baseline is conducted to enable the tracking of changes during the project's implementation phase.



This is followed by community entry and community dialogue activities to ensure permission to conduct the project and acquaint community leaders with the scope of the work.



Training for Facilitators who train c-MPDSR committees on implementing c-MPDSR and conducting Social Autopsies.



The community begins to track maternal and perinatal deaths, conduct verbal autopsies to ascertain the cause of death, and hold social autopsies on deaths where permission is given to do so.



Government and community stakeholders work together to monitor and evaluate progress and consider scale up.
